### WHO WE ARE

Alexander Devine Children's Hospice Service is a charity that provides specialist care and support to children with life-limiting and life-threatening conditions, and their families, across Berkshire and into surrounding counties.

Our vision is to provide a service within Berkshire and surrounding counties that will give children and families a choice of care and support from a skilled and dedicated team.

### **OUR MISSION**

Reaching out to every child and family who needs us

The specialist care and support we provide is free of charge for families. But it costs over

## £2.8 million+ each year

just to maintain our current level of care.

With very minimal government and NHS funding, 83% of what our charity needs to meet the cost of running our service comes from donations, fundraising and gifts in Wills.

This means for every one hour of specialist care and support that we provide to each child and their family, only 10 minutes is funded by statutory sources.


