- Write your full name**
The form must be clearly completed in your own handwriting.
- Fill in your home address**
Please do not include your work address as HMRC need to know where you live to claim Gift Aid.
- Avoid ditto marks**
Unfortunately, we cannot claim Gift Aid if you use ditto marks (") on the form.
- Write down your donation**
The most important bit - how much would you like to give to Alexander Devine?
- Tick the Gift Aid Box**
